

BYLAW 8/14
GARBAGE COLLECTION BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to regulate the collection and disposal of garbage by the Village.

Definition

2.
 - a) **“approved container”** means a container that meets the requirements of this Bylaw
 - b) **“automated collection”** means the collection of waste by a system of mechanical lifting and tipping of containers into specially designed vehicles
 - c) **“roll-out cart”** means a container on wheels approximately 0.4 cubic meters in volume and designed for automated collection
 - d) **“residence”** means a dwelling of any type as defined in the Zoning Bylaw
 - e) **“residential waste container”** means an approved container for use at your residence
 - f) **“Village”** means the Village of Buena Vista
 - g) **“waste collector”** means any appointed waste contractor, performing waste collector appointed by the Village
 - h) **“waste container”** means any container approved for waste collection

General

3. *Collection*
Garbage will be collected by the waste collector each Monday, Except for Christmas Day.
4. *Waste Containers*
Waste containers will be supplied by the collector and no other garbage container shall be used for waste collection in the Village.
5. An owner or occupant of a property within the Village shall ensure that there is unobstructed access to waste container.

6. No owner or occupant of a property that is assigned a roll-out cart shall place waste in any waste container except that container assigned to their property.
7. No person other than the owner, occupant or operator of a property to which a waste container is assigned shall disturb or disrupt the contents of a waste container.
8. No person shall deposit special or unacceptable waste into any waste container.
9. No person shall cause or permit any loss of, or damage to, a waste container.
10. Where automated waste collection from roll-out carts is in effect:
 - a) each residence shall be provided with one roll-out cart for the sole use of the owner or occupant of the residence; and
 - b) roll-out carts shall not be removed from the residence by the owner or occupant, or used for any purpose other than as permitted in this Bylaw.
11. Unless otherwise directed, roll-out carts must be:
 - a) set out at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day and placed:
 - (i) at least 1.3 metres from any obstructions such as parked vehicles
 - (ii) so that they will not be likely to overturn;
 - b) removed from the street as soon as possible, and in any event within 24 hours
 - (c) stored on the property of the residence when not placed out for collection

Offences

12. Every person commits an offence who:
 - a) causes or permits any loss of or damage to a waste container
 - b) leaves a waste container on a public right-of-way for more than 24 hours
 - c) fails to maintain a waste container in a sanitary state; and

No person shall:

- d) fail to comply with an order made under this Bylaw
- e) obstruct or hinder a municipal inspector acting under this Bylaw; or
- f) fail to comply with any other provision of this Bylaw.

Penalty

- 13. Any person who contravenes a provision of Section 12 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine:
 - a) for the first offence, of \$100.00
 - b) for a second offence, of \$200.00
 - c) for a third or subsequent offence, of not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$10,000.00.

Effective Date

- 14. This Bylaw shall come into force on the third and final reading by the Village of Buena Vista Council.
