

BYLAW NO. 10/94

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BUENA VISTA
FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF
SNOWMOBILES

The Council of the Village of Buena Vista in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provision contained in subsection (1) of Section 21 of The Snowmobile Act, R.S.S. 1978, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on any public highway in the corporate limits of the Village of Buena Vista only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12 midnight (local time).
2. Police officers and police constables while engaged in the performance of their duties are permitted to operate a snowmobile 24 hours a day on any public highway in the corporate limits of the Village of Buena Vista.
3. Any snowmobile found in contravention of The Snowmobile Act or this bylaw may be subject to seizure and impoundment for fourteen (14) days at the owner's expense.
4. A person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - (a) for the first offence to a fine of up to \$500.00 and in default of payment of the fine the person convicted may be committed to jail or to a public lock-up for any time determined by a Judge of the Provincial Court or Justice of the Peace not exceeding thirty (30) days, unless the penalty is sooner paid.
 - (b) for a second or subsequent offence to a fine of up to \$1,000.00 and in default of payment of the fine the person convicted may be committed to jail or to a public lock-up for any time determined by a Judge of the Provincial Court or Justice of the Peace not exceeding thirty (30) days, unless the penalty is sooner paid.
5. Sections 3.(g)(1) and (2) of Bylaw No. 4/85, are hereby repealed.


