ELECTION

The next election will take place Wednesday October 26, 2016. It is important to become involved in your community's affairs and exercise your democratic right to choose the leaders of your community.

Nomination Day will be September 21, 2016. At least 10 business days before Nomination Day, we will publish and post a Notice of Call for Nominations stating the vacancies to be filled by the election. Councillors are elected for a 4-year term, commencing with the first meeting following the election.

Nomination Day

Nominations can be filed at the Village office any time during regular office hours and from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Nomination Day.

Who Can Run?

Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate in an urban municipality must:

- be at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted; and have resided in Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted.

Nomination papers must be signed by at least 5 voters of the municipality.

Who Can Vote?

Eligible voters must be:

- at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day; and either:
 - a) a resident of the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election: or;
 - b) an owner of assessable land for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election.

How to Vote

Eligible voters can vote at the Village office from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Instructions on how to vote will be posted at the polling station. If you need help the Deputy Returning Officer who gives you the ballot will assist you.

Urban municipalities may make special provisions to accommodate voters with limited mobility by providing mobile polls and curbside voting.

The names of the candidates for mayor and councillors are listed on the ballots for each office. The names will be alphabetical. The candidate's occupation, if any, is printed beneath the candidate's name.

You may vote for only one candidate for mayor, and no more than the stated number of councillors, by making a distinct "X" in the space beside the candidate's name. The ballot is secret.

Advance Poll

The Village will hold an advance poll immediately before Election Day.

Voting at Advance Poll is conducted in the same manner as at a regular poll. The location and hours of the Advance Poll will be advertised soon.

CENSUS OF POPULATION PROGRAM

The Census is taking place now. It is very important to the Municipality that you complete your census form as we obtain funding based on the information provided on each census from returned.

Water Security Agency Spring Runoff info April 26, 2016

Last Mountain Lake peaked late last week and has been holding steady near 490.25 m, which is near the top of its desirable summer operating range (489.66 to 490.27 m). Approximately 1.5 m³/s is entering the Last Mountain Lake from the Qu'Appelle River at Craven. This will be the final Spring Runoff Update for the season. WSA will however make information available if a significant runoff event is forecasted or occurring. The publication of Water Supply Condition and Outlook reports will resume in early May.
