

Bylaw Enforcement

The Village of Buena Vista has hired the Commissionaires South Saskatchewan to enforce the bylaws. The Commissionaires will be easily recognisable as they wear uniforms and will be driving a clearly identifiable vehicle. The Commissionaires have full authority to enforce the bylaws of the Village and in doing so may have to come onto your property, this is covered in Section 362 of the Municipalities Act.

The service provided by the Commissionaires is essential to the Village so please respect them in the course of their duty. If you wish to learn more about the services they provide, visit their website at www.commissionaires.ca

- Property taxes are due December 31, 2015. Commencing January 1, 2016 any unpaid taxes will incur interest on the first day of each month until paid in full and if will become part of the Tax Enforcement process
- Water accounts must be paid in full before December 31, 2015. Any outstanding water accounts will be transferred to taxes and will incur interest on the first day of each month until paid in full.
- Keep paths to water meters or readouts clear of debris and snow to help our staff make the process as quick and safe as possible during the winter months.
- Please ensure you garbage and recycling carts, or any motorised vehicle or trailers are kept on your lot.

Please note there is no longer a boat launch facility in the Village.

Council are reminding people that there are **NO** motorised vehicles of any type allowed in Dobson Park except for emergency vehicles!
