## Spring:

- Drainage plan on Highwood has been completed by SS Bobcat, cleanup still have to be completed by our staff, will have to be completed in the spring.
- New hydrant has been installed on Highwood. Needs to be back filled and landscaped around it, will have to be completed in the spring.
- Woodland Bay drainage is complete. Needs more traffic gravel and grading to be done until road is packed good. Road is still really soft, Karen getting pricing for heavier gravel.
